Steven Goldberg is a Professor of Law at the Georgetown University Law Center in Washington, DC. An expert in law and science, his books include *Culture Clash: Law and Science in America* (winner of the Alpha Sigma Nu Book Award) and *Seduced By Science: How American Religion Has Lost Its Way*. He is also coauthor of the widely used text, *Law, Science and Medicine*.

Mr. Goldberg was born in Washington, DC, and grew up in the nearby Maryland suburbs. After graduation from Harvard College and Yale Law School, he served as a law clerk to Chief Judge David L. Bazelon of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, and to Justice William J. Brennan, Jr. of the United States Supreme Court. He then served as an attorney in the General Counsel's Office of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission before joining the Georgetown Law Faculty.

Mr. Goldberg has published, taught, and lectured extensively on law and science. He also teaches constitutional law, contracts, administrative law, and law and religion. He is a member of the American Bar Association's section on law and science and of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

Mr. Goldberg and his wife Miriam live in Chevy Chase, Maryland. They have two children, Joseph and Rebecca.
