Michael Hogan is responsible for liaison with the voluntary standards community for the Information Technology Laboratory (ITL) at the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST)*. He represents NIST at national and international voluntary standards organizations that manage the development of standards and associated testing methodologies for information technology (IT), and he participates in the development of policies on standards and conformity assessment issues. Mr. Hogan is presently serving as the NIST member of the Executive Board of the International Committee for Information Technology Standards (INCITS) and as a NIST representative to INCITS Technical Committee M1, Biometrics.

From 1982 to 1987, he managed the NIST Computer Storage Media Group, which conducted research in methods to characterize and measure magnetic and optical digital data storage media. In previous positions at NIST, he developed reference measurement services and data interchange standards for computer storage media. An Electronics Engineer, Mr. Hogan has worked at the National Institute of Standards and Technology (formerly National Bureau of Standards) since June 1974.
