Ben Miller is founder and Chair of Inside ID: The Identification Solutions Mega Show, the leading conference and exhibition focusing on modern identification management and technology.

Mr. Miller previously founded the CardTech/SecurTech Conference in 1990 and oversaw growth of that event until 2000.

Mr. Miller has been involved with transaction systems and security solutions since 1981. He oversaw the first implementation of an ATM using hand geometry biometrics for the US Army at Ft. Benjamin Harrison and was the project leader on the Agriculture Department's first feasibility study of replacing paper food stamps with card technology.

A frequent speaker and author on card based transaction systems and identification technology, Mr. Miller is often quoted in newspapers and journals. He has served as an advisor to the U.S. Congress and National Academy of Science. He has provided consulting services to major corporate and government agencies including American Express, the DoD, Visa, IBM and many others.

In September 1996, he was presented with the "Distinguished Achievement Award" by the Smart Card Alliance and received a similar distinction from the Advance Card Technology Association of Canada the following year. He was elected to the Smart Card Hall of Fame in 1998 and is a member of the advisory board of the International Biometric Industry Association (IBIA).
