Dr. Alvin Martin is a federal employee with 12 years of service in the Speech Group at the National Institute of Standards and Technology. He was previously involved in research and development of automatic systems for speech recognition, keyword spotting, and language identification at Verbex Corporation and at GTE Government Systems.

Dr. Martin has, since 1996, coordinated NIST's annual evaluation of text-independent automatic speaker recognition systems on conversational telephone speech. Participants have included companies, universities, and other research laboratories from around the world. In 2000 he received the United States Department of Commerce Bronze Medal Award "for leadership in the development and implementation of benchmark test protocols for large vocabulary speech and speaker recognition technologies".

Alvin Martin received a B.S. in Mathematics from The University of Chicago and an M.S. and Ph.D. in Mathematics from Yale University. He is married and has three children.
