Biography: Jeff Dunn is a career federal employee with 26 years of service at the National Security Agency. His current position is Technical Director for Biometrics within the Research Directorate. This directorate conducts leading-edge research to support the NSA signals intelligence and information assurance missions. During his NSA career, Mr. Dunn has held a variety of program manager and management positions.

Mr. Dunn serves as a member of the Advisory Board of the Center for Identification Technology Research at West Virginia University, a National Science Foundation sponsored center for conducting research in biometrics and related fields. He represents NSA at the National Science and Technology Council Subcommittee on Biometrics. He co-authored the Common Biometric Exchange File Format specification and has published several papers on biometric technologies. Mr. Dunn consults on biometric technologies to a wide range of Government organizations and he has testified at congressional hearings on biometric technology.
